Youth Symphony sets concert

If the first movement from the *D Minor Symphony* by Frank, the *Blue Danube Waltz* by Strauss and the *1812 Overture* by Tchaikovsky sound like an ambitious program from young musicians, it's true. But that they are up to the task will be demonstrated at a complementary concert on Monday, May 13.

The performance by the Everett Junior Symphony, under the direction of Parke Burgess, starts at 7 pm at South Whidbey Intermediate School.

The Junior Symphony is composed of students training for the Everett Youth Symphony and includes local members Trystan Matthews-Jensen and Marnie Jensen on cello, Hallie Larsen and Aaron Parks-Stein on bassoon, Logan McInerney and Daniel Smith on percussion, Jenny Volgesberg on Clarinet, Noboru Jones on trumpet and Linda Godsey on tuba.

The youngest symphony in the Everett program is the Young Strings whose members include violinists Devin Matthews-Jensen and Nancy Godsey, and Linda Godsey on string bass.
